It is formulated for use with pre-plant or liquid starter fertilizers, including polyphosphates and nitrogen solutions. **Zinc 10%** is recommended for crops that require high zinc usage, such as corn, edible beans, onions and potatoes. **Zinc 10%** is generally compatible with fertilizer solutions. Proper timing, rate, and placement is important for desired results. Results are dependent on stage growth of crop, soil fertility levels, and environmental conditions.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE + APPLICATION RATES

Broadcast Soil Treatment: 1-4 qts (1-4 L) per acre  
Row Application: 1-4 qts (1-4 L) per acre
